

**Jefferson County Commissioner Meeting Minutes
February 27, 2014**

Special meeting held to discuss Indigent Lien on Indigent Case number 35-10. Those Present are Chairman Raymond, Commissioner Farnsworth, Commissioner Hegsted is appearing telephonically, and Emily Kramer. Edidt Ramirez and Chris Boulter are clerking the board.

Motion to amend agenda to discuss a Planning and Zoning issue due to a hard deadline with The City of Rigby, new information has just been called to attention, made by Commissioner Farnsworth, motion is seconded by Chairman Raymond. Roll call vote- Farnsworth-aye, Hegsted-aye, Raymond-aye. Motion carried

Naysha Foster-Planning and Zoning

A legal notice has to be sent to The Jefferson Star by tomorrow to amend the refund portion of the Ordinance. There is recommendation to eliminate the refund portion of building permits. Commissioners direct planning and zoning to send out notice to conduct a public hearing to repeal refund portion of the ordinance at this time.

Motion made to publish notice by Commissioner Farnsworth seconded by Hegsted aye, all in favor. Motion carried

Naysha informs the commissioners she was researching the zoning application. County does not meet description of commercial use; however we do meet the definition of a public facility. The city ordinance allows for a public facility use. The city is not willing to waive the application fee for the zone change application. Commissioners wish to meet with the City Mayor to discuss these pending issues. Invite mayor to Naysha's office to meet with them and a commissioner from the board to discuss the application issue.
